

<b>Steve Scott's Five Minute Personality Test</b>							
Look at the four words on each line.							
Rank those four words according to how they <b>BEST</b> describe you.							
A word or words that <b>MOST</b> describes you gets a 4, the <b>LEAST</b> gets a 1.							
Put the Number 4 next to the world that <b>MOST</b> describes you.							
Put the number 1 next to the word or words that <b>LEAST</b> describes you.							
Put the number 2 and 3 next to the word or words that second and third best describe you.							
Do not put more than one of any number on a horizontal line.
